TECHNICAL DATA

The exhibition is composed of 72 canvas sheets (polyester sheets classified M1).

Each canvas sheet is 150 cm large x 210 cm high.

Each canvas sheet is equipped with a metal rail-cum-hooks at the top and one metal rail for weight at the bottom.

They can be hooked onto walls, suspended from the ceiling...

The exhibition comes in 8 boxes.

Each box is ca. 160x40x40 cm and weighs an average of 30 kilos.
